Vehicles and drivers to transport artists and guitars from the Airport on Thursday evening and to and from the venue and hotel on Friday

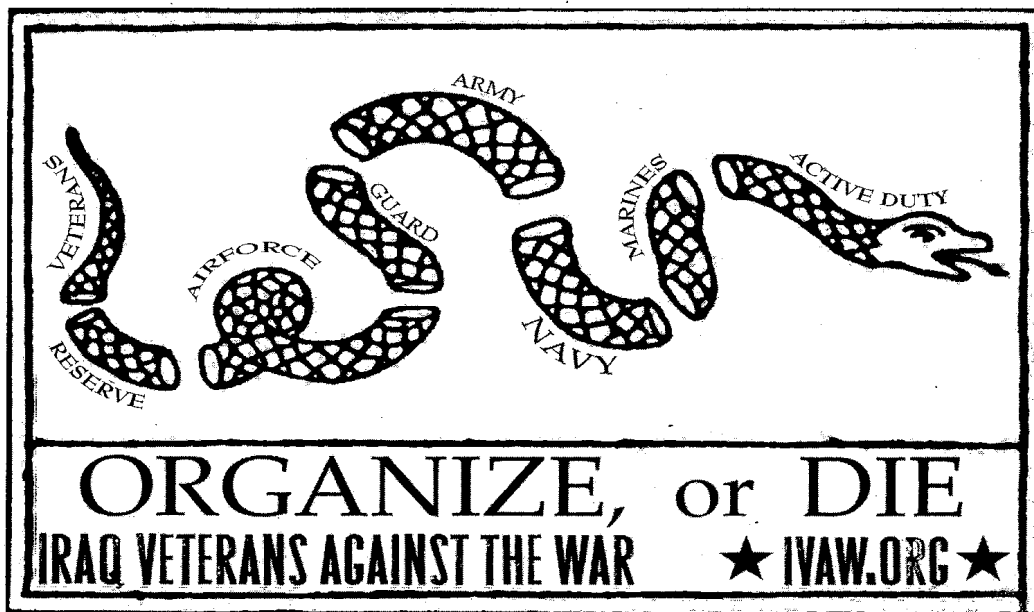

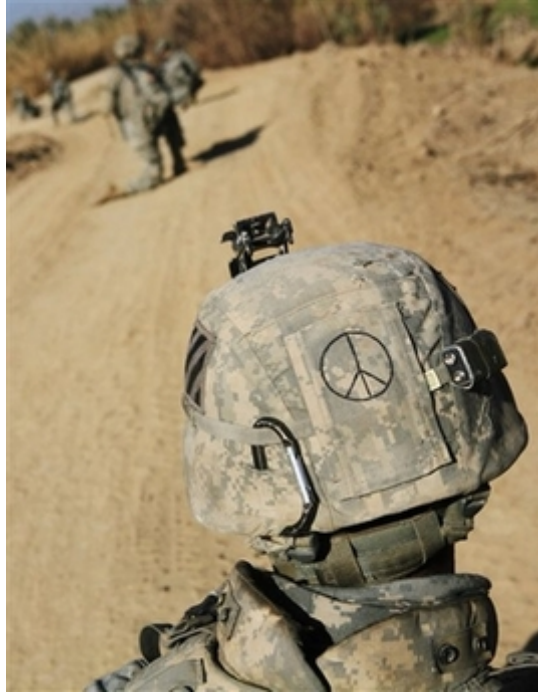
